President's Message

Dearest Members, Welcome to a new year! And with a new year comes resolutions and changesí in CSI terms:

Resolutions are the result of claims for compensation that can be made by various stakeholders in a project: Owners, subcontractors, workers.

Trying to get a resolution before litigation with your contractor is key. Avoiding large expense when getting into this stage is dependent on how well your project documents are prepared and to a point how well you treat each other. Make your Project Documents as CLEAR, CONCISE, CORRECT and COMPLETE as possible and treat each other with respect and empathy, and things will go much smoother.

CLEAR, CONCISE, CORRECT and COMPLETE. The 4 Cos are critical. Donot let a crunch in time or personnel lead you to issue a project that has not been properly vetted. You need to have a second set of eyes review those drawings and specifications. How? Use the resources you already have! Have your peers review the drawings before they go out. Have your Product Representatives review the project documents related to their product. In case you still need help, hire a competing firm to review your drawings (the more competitive, the better). Believe it or not, your investment in the 4 Cos before your project goes out will pay you back tenfold in reduction of contract disputes, change orders, time delays, and cost overruns.

And how about those change orders?

Change orders are defined as a change in the scope of work that causes a time or monetary change. A change order begins when an Architectural Supplemental Instruction, ASI, is issued. When there is no effect on the time or cost of the project, it stays as a ASI. Once there is a time or cost change, it becomes a change order. Remember, the cost of the change order is not only the final number that is issued, but also the cost for administering it. Change orders are a natural part of the construction industry. But when you are receiving a change order every other day, you need to understand that a change order can cost several times as if it was done correctly the first time. Much more if it involves demolition and redesign.

This is the time to look at your preconstruction process. Here again the four Cøs will help you to limit the number of change orders that you receive. Looking at each specification and each drawing and answering the question: õHave you addressed the 4 Cøs?ö yes, will help you to avoid costly change orders and litigation.

Take care of your project as if it was your first child, not your fifth.
