CALL TO ORDER:

Larry Whitlock called meeting to order at 12:04 pm

MEETING MINUTES:

March 7, 2016 Board Meeting Minutes approved.

Membership (AG): Anthony will be contacting young architects and engineers.

Finance (SM): We need to review the costs and our ticket price associated with our construct special event. Brazos required and we paid a \$6,000 deposit. We can, if we want, get a loan from CSI National to cover deposits.

By-Laws (TA): No Report

Archives (JWB): Ongoing.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Motion was made to accept the proposal from Brazos hall which includes having Brazos Hall purchase and serve the alcohol. Marina seconded. Motion approved.

Total budget for the event is \$22,500. For alcohol, the Chapter will carry a budget of \$8,400. The Chapter will cover \$5,000 and could be liable for the balance of \$3,400 if attendees do not purchase additional drinks beyond the two drinks at \$7.00 per drink.

- Bands:

Board discussed Weldon Henson and Graham Wilkinson. Larry mentioned he would send the Board a Youtube video to review.

- Sponsors:

It was agreed to have three levels of sponsors:

- Platinum Sponsors - 4 at \$1,000 each
- Gold Sponsor - unlimited at \$250 each
- Bronze Sponsor - unlimited at \$100 each

In lieu of using the names of precious metals to designate the different levels of sponsorship, it was suggested to use names such as Lonestar and Yellow Rose of Texas as a way of tying the event to Texas.

- Larry will contact David Brady regarding the Chapter's participation in the High Performance Buildings and Workplaces Conference and Exposition to be held on May 3rd and May 4th. Marina will be at the conference representing Cosella Dorken.
- Scholarship Fund: it was suggested to have the CSI College of Fellows Chancellor, Sheldon Wolfe, present a check to the UT School of Architecture at the CSI Convention. Larry will contact Sheldon.
- Jody has been in contact with Poke Joes for the food for the event. Rough budget of \$5,000 plus a 10 to 20 percent service fee.

NEW BUSINESS:

- CSI Austin Special Even at Construct 2016
 - Brazos Hall capacity is 499. We are projecting attendance to be at or about 300 and a ticket price of \$75 for a total of \$22,500 in revenue.
 - Robin has a contract/ offer from the band Weldon Henson and Graham Wilkinson for \$1,200. Before Weldon and Graham perform a band made up of Architects will play.
- Scholarship Fund: Larry contacted Sheldon Wolfe, Chancellor of the CSI College of Fellows, and informed him that due to costs related to our special event at Construct 2016 we will not be able to match the scholarship amount of \$1,500 to the UT School of Architecture
- Informa Exhibits www.informaexhibits.com has been contracted to handle Construct www.constructshow.com at the Austin Convention Center Sept 7-9, 2016.
- Social Media: Brad Bennett suggested CSI Austin needed to increase its presence in social media, ie Facebook, LinkedIn, etc.
 - Anthony volunteered to tackle our social media needs and programs.
