## Concrete Restoration, Joint Treatment and Crack Repair

### Course Description:

This course provides an overview of the key factors in the proper specification and installation of concrete joints, as well as discussions on the methods and materials that are used to repair cracks and spalling.

## President's Message Continued

### **CHAPTER ELECTIONS FOR FY2016!**

It's not too early to begin thinking about electing officers and directors for FY2016. Article VI of the By-Laws reads:

#### **Section 1.**

Officers and directors shall be elected to those offices as established by Article IV by the members of the chapter. When the new president assumes office, the current president-elect shall assume without election the office of president and the current president shall assume without election the office of immediate past president.

#### **Section 2.**

Each elected board member shall take office on July 1.

#### **Section 3.**

The president/president-elect or vice president shall not hold the same office for more than two consecutive terms.

#### **Section 4.**

The term of office for directors shall be three-year terms with one-third of the directors being elected each year.

#### **Section 5.**

The Board shall appoint a nominating committee not later than the Board meeting prior to the February chapter meeting. The nominating committee shall prepare a list of nominees, showing at least one name for each elective position on the board due to become vacant, and present the list to the chapter not later than the regular meeting in April. At this time, the members may present nominations from the floor. Election shall be by written ballot. The nominating committee shall prepare the ballot, which shall include the original list of nominees and those nominated from the floor. Each voting member of the chapter shall be provided with a ballot at least two weeks prior to the ballot count. Eligibility to vote shall be as defined in the Institute Bylaws. The winners shall be determined by a simple majority of votes cast before and during the meeting.

#### **Section 6.**

The ballots shall be counted and certified at the April chapter meeting, by tellers appointed by the president, and the results shall be reported to the members.

#### **Section 7.**

Not later than April 30, the chapter secretary shall notify the Institute directors and the Institute office of the results of the election and shall submit to them a complete listing of the chapter officers for the coming year, with their addresses and telephone numbers

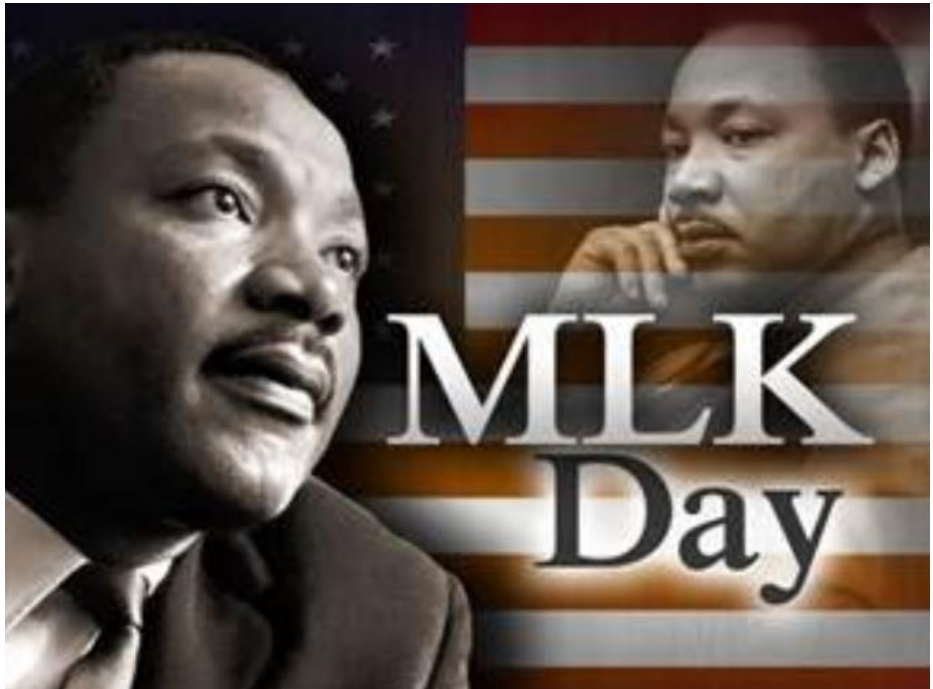
